Preamble

The Karnataka State Board of Wakf, Bangalore which was constituted as per the Government Notification No. MWD 237 WES 2011, dated:20-08-2011 for a period of five years was expired on 19-08-2016.

Consequent upon Amendment to the Wakf Act 1995 (Amendment No.27 of 2013), the existing Karnataka Wakf Rules 1997 has to be amended suitably to reconstitute the Karnataka State Board of Wakf as per Sec. 14 of Wakf Act 1995. Hence to look after the day to day affairs of the Wakf Board, Sri Mohammad Mohsin, IAS, Secretary, Minority Welfare Haj & Wakf Department was appointed as Administrator of the Karnataka State Board of Auqaf, Bangalore for a period of six month with effect from 20-08-2016 vide Government Order read at (1) above in the first instances.

Since the Karnataka Wakf Amendment Rules-2017 were under process, the period of the Administrator of the Karnataka State Board of Wakf has been further extended for a period of Six month with effect from 22-02-2017, vide Government order read at (2) above. The said period will also expire on 19-08-2017.

After finalization of the Karnataka Wakf Amendment Rules 2017 and published in the Official Gazzette on 07-06-2017, Notification was issued on 17-07-2017 appointing Smt. M.V.Jayanti, IAS., Regional Commissioner, Bangalore Division as an Electoral Registration Officer under Rule 11 of the Karnataka Wakf Rules 2017 as per Amendment to Wakf (Amendment) Act of 2013. The Regional Commissioner Bangalore Electoral Registration Officer has completed the process of publication of Electoral Roll of six Categories of Section 14 of the Wakf Act. Subsequently the said Regional Commissioner Bangalore Division has been appointed as Returning Officer to conduct the

Election. By the time publication of the Calendar of event, enforcement of code of conduct for the ensuing election to the Legislative Assembly came into force from 27-03-2018. Hence the period of the Administrator to the Wakf Board is required to be further extended for a period of Six months or till the composition of the regular Wakf Board whichever is earlier.

In view of the above facts, the Government is pleased to extend the appointment of Sri Mohammad Mohsin IAS., Secretary to Government, Minority Welfare Haj & Wakf Department, Bangalore as an Administrator of Karnataka State Board of Auqaf, Bangalore for a period of Six months with effect from 20-02-2018 till the composition of regular Wakf Board, whichever is earlier.
