C I R C U L A R

Sub: Implementation of Karnataka Waqf Rules, 2017
in the State of Karnataka – reg.
Ref: Govt. notification No.MWD/169/WES/2016,
dated:06-06-2017.

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Whereas the Karnataka Waqf Rules, 2017 have been published in the Special State Gazette on 06-07-2017. As per Rule 100 of these Rules the Karnataka Waqf Rules, 1997 have been repealed, notwithstanding anything done under the said Rules shall be deemed to have been done under the corresponding provisions of these Rules.

Under these Rules the Survey Commissioner of Waqf shall be the Commissioner Survey Settlement and Land Records. The Survey Commissioner shall submit the survey report to the Secretary to Government, Revenue Department for publication in the Gazette. Within thirty (30) days from the date of receipt of letter from the Department of Minority Welfare & Waqf the Authorities of Revenue, Rural Development & Panchayath Raj and Urban Development shall mutate the Khata of Waqf lands in their respective records. The Mutawallies of Waqf Institutions shall get the Khatas updated with words "**Waqf Property**" followed by the name of the Waqf.

Within six (6) months from the date of commencement of these Rules the Auqaf save and except the Auqaf having their Deed of Waqf (Waqif Name) shall frame the Scheme of Management in Form No.42 and get the approval of the Board. Failing which the District Waqf Officer shall take steps to frame the Scheme of Management within a period of three (3) months after taking over the management of Waqf.

A Mutawalli or a member of the Managing Committee of Waqf shall possess the qualifications indicated in Rule 53 positively. If in the event of the existing Committee fails to initiate and complete the process of constitution of succeeding Committee within the time prescribed the District Waqf Officer shall initiate such process within two (2) months prior to the expiry of the term of the existing Committee and complete the process prior to the expiry of the term. If for any reasons succeeding Committee is not constituted the Management of Waqf shall automatically vest with the concerned District Waqf Officer or any other officer authorized by the Board. Such officer shall take action to get the succeeding Committee constituted within a period of three (3) months. The former Committee shall cease to have power for management including operation of Bank Account after expiry of the term.
