

PROCEEDINGS OF THE KARNATAKA STATE BOARD OF AUQAF, BENGALURU.

Sub: Empanelment of Election Officers to conduct the election of various Waqf institutions in the State.

PREAMBLE:

Various Waqf institutions in the Karnataka State Board of Auqaf, Bengaluru, are required to conduct election once in three (3) years as per the approved Scheme of Administration of the concerned Waqf institutions. The election to the Waqf institutions is being conducted at present by the Officials working in the Office of the Karnataka State Board of Auqaf, Bengaluru. There are huge number of Waqf institutions for which free & fair election has to be conducted in case the selection is not done with consensus and on orders of the Government, Karnataka State Board of Auqaf and Courts, these institutions are unable to hold elections due to non-availability of suitable experienced officials in the jurisdiction of the Waqf institutions.

The Board vide Notification No.KSBW/ADM/EST/01/2014-15 dated:30-03-20147 has invited application for appointment of Election Officers to conduct election to the Managing Committees of Waqf institutions across the State. In response to this, 20 applications are received and all the applicants were invited on 24-05-2017 at the Office of the Karnataka State Board of Auqaf, Bengaluru They were trained by the Administrator, Karnataka State Board of Auqaf, Bengaluru and Senior Officers of the Board.

As per the proceedings of the meeting convened on 24-05-2017, it is decided to empanel the Election Officers.

Hence, this order.

ORDER NO. KSBA/ADM/EST/1/14-15 DATED:22-09-2017

In view of the facts mentioned in the preamble, the Karnataka State Board of Auqaf, hereby empanel the following retired officials and in service Officials as Election Officers to conduct Elections to the managing Committees of Waqf institutions across the State. Remuneration of Rs.15,000/- is fixed for institutions below 1000 voters and Rs.25,000/- for above 1000 voters. Upto Rs. 5,000/- can be used as incidental charges.
