## All India Conference of State/UT Waqf Boards held at New Delhi on 07-May-2018



All India Conference of State/UT Waqf Boards held at SCOPE Complex, Lodhi Road, New Delhi on 07-May-2018 to review the progress of Waqf Related Schemes and implementation of Waqf Act and Rules. Member of Parliament Shri Hussain Dalwai, J&K Minority Affairs Minister Shri Zulfikar Ali, Minority Affairs Secretary Shri Ameizing Luikham, Jt. Secretary Shri Jan-e-Alam, Central Waqf Council Secretary Shri B M Jamal, Chairmen, Members and Chief Executive Officers from all the State/UT Waqf Boards and other officials were present on the occasion. This National Waqf Conference was organized to review the progress of the implementation of Waqf Act 1995 as amended, Waqf Properties Lease Rule, 2014 and "Qaumi Waqf Board Taraqqiati Scheme".

During the inaugural speech, Honourable Union Minister for Minority Affairs Shri Mukhtar Abbas Naqvi said that under "Pradhan Mantri Jan Vikas Karykram" (PMJVK), the Minority Affairs Ministry will construct schools, colleges, ITIs, skill development centers, multi-purpose community centers "Sadbhav Mandap", "Hunar Hub", Hospitals, Business Centers etc on Waqf properties across the country. This will be for the first time after the Independence of the country that Union Cabinet approved the PMJVK, which has provision to utilize Waqf properties for various infrastructures projects for socio-economic-educational empowerment of the society. Total 308 districts, 870 blocks, 331 towns and 1000s of villages have been covered under PMJVK. This would accelerate the utilization of Waqf properties for the benefit of the society.



Shri Naqvi said that the Waqf Lease rules are being made easy and effective to ensure better utilization of Waqf properties and to free these Waqf properties several of them are entangled in disputes for several decades, from disputes. Waqf properties in several states are not being utilized Waqf properly due to these complicated rules.

Shri Naqvi further said that Central Waqf Council is providing financial help to State/UT Waqf Boards for digitalization of Waqf records so that State/UT Waqf Boards can complete digitalization work within decided timeframe as 84% Waqf properties have already been digitized. Remaining Waqf properties will also be digitized soon. Two (2) Legal Support Officers, 2 Zonal Waqf Officers, 2 Surveyors are being deployed by Central Waqf Council in State/UT Waqf Boards for preservation, maintenance, development of Waqf properties and sort out legal matters.

The conference also reviewed the status of remodeled "Qaumi Waqf Board Taraqqiati Scheme" implemented by Central Waqf Council to achieve optimum results in order to make State/UT Waqf Boards self-reliant leading to better implementation of their welfare activities for betterment of the community. About Rs.48 Crores have been earmarked for the "Qaumi Waqf Board Taraqqiati Scheme" and transparent digital record of Waqf properties and to free them from encroachments through GIS/GPS mapping of the Waqf properties.
